
TESTIMONIES of

B ritta and I started with nothing. Her father was a blue-collar bus driver and her mother a homemaker. Britta went to university and became a Registered Nurse. I was a refugee to Sweden and possessed nothing.

At our wedding, Britta wore a simple cotton wedding dress sewn by a friend. I wore a rented suit. This is how we started our marriage and began to serve God together. We were far from being rich and lived in humble circumstances.

As we grew in God's grace and He blessed us, we decided to live by certain principles when it comes to our finances:



1. Always live lives of contentment, thankful to God for what he had given us. Whether it was little or much, we would always be thankful for what God had blessed us with and never allow money to be a driving force in our lives.

"But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. And having food and raiment let us be therewith content." 1 Tim 6:6-7

2. Always put God and His Kingdom first when it comes to money. We would not live in a fancy "parsonage" built with ministry money or drive a fancy car bought with ministry money. Ministry money would be kept separate from our personal finances and would be used for the furtherance of the Gospel. We would have a "no frills" ministry and win as many souls as possible with the resources that God had entrusted us with. Everything that God had put into our hands was for the use of the Gospel alone.

3. Always have an open home. People would always be welcome to visit us. We received friends who would visit and needed a bed to sleep in. Hospitality would be a way of life for us.

4. Never live beyond our means. Especially after moving to America, we would not get into debt buying expensive things to give the impression that we were wealthier than we were. We decided not to charge to our credit cards more than what we could pay off at the end of every month.

5. Never squander money on expensive things that we had no real use for. Status symbols would never have any meaning for us. We were not out to impress anyone with our cars, watches, clothes, expensive vacations, or jewelry, but we would live a simple lifestyle and not above the level of the people who supported our ministry.

6. NEVER speak poverty or lack in our home.

We would never utter words like "We cannot afford that" or "We just don't have enough money." Words become milestones in our lives. That is why we would never speak the language of lack or poverty in our family. If we did not have the money for it, we would not buy it, but rather sow seeds and wait until we had the money.

7. Always be generous in sowing financial seeds. We would always tithe and be generous to people. Over the years we have always been tithers and givers. Many years ago in Sweden, we went through a time when we had very little money, but we still made sure that we always paid our tithes. We choose to trust God to be our provider. Through those hard times we stayed tithers and generous givers. We blessed others in need, even though we ourselves had little. Through those tough years we saw God's miraculous provision and faithfulness upon our family.

8. Getting or not getting Tax Deductions would NEVER determine or ever be a consideration in our giving. We are blessed that in the United States we have tax deductibility when we give to non-profit ministries and churches, but that should never stop us from giving gifts to individuals who are not tax deductible. If God leads us to bless someone with a gift, even a large gift, we should obey and give, even when there is no tax money coming back to us. Let us look to God for our reward and not the IRS. I want you all to know that the principle of Seedtime and Harvest really works!

Our God is ever Faithful!

Lastly remember this: "For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out." 1 Tim 6:7

We came to this world with nothing, and everything that we have accumulated will be left behind when it is time to leave this world. Let us be ever mindful of this!

But yes! There is one thing that we can take with us, and those are the souls that we win for Jesus. We can take them with us to spend eternity with Jesus!

So, let us be wise stewards of the resources that God puts into our hands, and live our lives with an eternal perspective. Let us invest our lives, our talents, abilities, and our money into soulwinning and such matters that pertain to eternity.

We began this year with two **Gospel Crusades** in very difficult to reach, remote areas in Asia. We saw God move in these places with good harvests of souls for Jesus. We were blessed to see sinners coming to Jesus, and the Lord confirming the Gospel message with signs following. Paralyzed individuals walked, blind people received their sight, deaf people received their hearing, and many more miracles occurred.

After that we held our eight **Gospel Crusades in Africa:** four Crusades in Mozambique and four in remote parts of northern Zambia. We saw God do great and wonderful things in these Crusades with a large harvest of souls in every Crusade. Multiplied thousands were baptized with the Holy Spirit, and we saw God do many wonderful miracles.



In addition to this, we held two Schools of Ministry Conferences for Pastors in northern Zambia and two Childrens Crusades.

As you are reading this, I am in Asia for two more Gospel Crusades and Schools of Ministry for Pastors in remote places.

We are thankful for all of the open doors that the Lord has given us!
