

THE FIRE FALLS IN GORONGOSA, MOZAMBIQUE

Gorongosa is a small town in the center of Mozambique which has never been touched by a Gospel Crusade or outreach of any kind. The road to this town is difficult to navigate, with huge craters, taking hours on end just to drive short distances. Gorongosa was the headquarters of the violent guerrilla movement that had been fighting the government for decades. The week of our Gospel crusade, the government signed a peace accord with the rebels. The country was finally at peace as the rebels turned in their arms while we were there. The highest government official for the region told me, "Pastor, it is significant that you are holding the first ever crusade here and are preaching the Gospel of Peace in this region at the same time as peace is being declared over our nation."

Our vehicles and equipment had a rough time getting into Gorongosa, and I flew in on a tiny aircraft that landed on a grassy strip over two hours away. We were excited to be there to proclaim our Lord Jesus, and there was great anticipation among the people. We found out that people had walked from as far away as 30 to 40 kilometers (18 to 25 miles) to hear the Gospel preached. Imagine being that hungry for the Word of God!



I was very tired after my trip, so I asked my team member, Pastor Farai, to preach, and I would pray for the sick afterwards. A crowd had come out to hear the Gospel, and many responded to the Gospel message and were saved.

People were healed and testified of what the Lord had done for them.

The deaf could hear, the blind could see and the lame could walk!









Many others testified of the things that the Lord had done for them.

I was surprised to see how the crowd had grown the next evening. Many people came to the Crusade in this little rural village. I was told that many people had come from other villages and towns in the region to hear the Gospel.

They responded to the Gospel and a huge multitude prayed with us to give their lives to the Lord



Jesus.

The Lord gave great grace and confirmed His Word with signs following:

- Several people had their deaf ears opened.
- A boy who was born mute was brought to the Crusade by his mother. He had never uttered a sound in his life. The Lord loosened his tongue, and he began to speak and repeat words perfectly.
- A girl who was blind in both eyes received her sight.
- A man who was blind in one eye also received his sight.

Many others also testified of the wonderful things that the Lord had done for them. In addition, a very large number of demon possessed people were carried into our prayer tent where they were delivered and set free.

The crowds grew nightly and multitudes of hungry souls gave their lives to our Lord Jesus.

- The next night the very first healing testimony was that of a 23-year-old man who was born deaf. Jesus touched him and gave him perfect hearing. The young man was very joyful and grateful for what the Lord had done for him.
- The second testimony was from an elderly woman who was blind in both eyes. She said that previously she could see nothing but darkness. Our Lord Jesus healed her, and she could see perfectly, even people standing very far away across the field.









After that we heard the testimonies of many deaf people who received their hearing, and people who suffered from different diseases and infirmities and were made whole.

My team and I never cease to be astounded at the compassion and the power of our Glorious Lord Jesus. It is such a privilege to see Him touch people, restore their lives, and make them whole. We see this all the time, yet we never cease to be gripped by all that He does in people's lives. May He always keep us at a place of childlike awe and fascination.

Friday night's service was cancelled because it had rained the entire day.

The Lord moved mightily on Saturday with the multitude responding to the altar call after I preached from 1 Peter 2:24.

The Lord then confirmed His Word with signs, wonders, and miracles. Among some of the miracles that we saw our Lord Jesus do in our midst were the following:

- A completely blind woman received her sight.
- A child who could neither walk nor speak both walked and spoke after Jesus touched him.
- Another child who could not walk stood up and began to walk
- A man in his 20's who could not walk and was carried to the meeting, was laying on a blanket on the field. When the power of God touched him, he got up, walked, and danced.
- Another man who was paralyzed in one leg and deaf in one ear was completely healed and walked and danced.
- A boy who was paralyzed on one side of his body was healed.
- Many people who were deaf in one or both ears received perfect hearing. Others were healed from different kinds of diseases and infirmities.

We are living in the Book of Acts!







The people in Gorongosa were simple African country folks, and they received the Gospel message wholeheartedly. That is why God moved amongst them in such a manner night after night.

Our wonderful Lord Jesus is full of mercy and compassion. He bore our sins, diseases, and our infirmities upon His own self, and He saves and heals all those who come to Him and trust Him. Thank you, Lord, for this Glorious Gospel. What a privilege it is to serve our Lord Jesus in the far corners of the earth!

On the last night, a huge multitude gave their lives to our Lord Jesus. The Spirit of the Lord fell with power, and thousands were baptized with the Holy Ghost and with Fire. It was an African Pentecost! After that, many people testified of the miracles that the Lord had done for them.

Thank you for sending us out to the Harvest fields. Thank you for your prayers and support! All Glory to our Lord Jesus for all that He has done.

There are around 360 pastors in the entire region leading very small congregations, and most do not have Bibles. We have sent our Overseer for Mozambique \$3,800 to purchase Bibles for all of them. An Assemblies of God church in Virginia has met this need. Praise the Lord!
